Where do you work? What's your job?

Positive adjectives: good, interesting, satisfying, stimulating, challenging, rewarding, creative.

Negative adjectives: (extremely) boring, difficult, tiring, exhausting, dead-end, not rewarding.

Ex: I like my job because finding solutions for our clients is very satisfying and challenging but my job is also very tiring and can sometimes be difficult.

General vocabulary:

- I'm a freelancer = I'm self-employed = I run my own business
- I'm between jobs at the moment = I'm unemployed
- I'm retired = I don't work anymore
